

NFU Scotland member referral scheme

Effective: May 2026 - 15 October 2026

1. Overview

The NFU Scotland (NFUS) Member Referral Scheme rewards existing members who refer new, full-paying members to the Union. For each eligible referral, the referring member will receive a 10% discount on their 2027 membership fee, up to a maximum of 100% (10 successful referrals).

2. Eligibility

- The scheme is open to current NFUS members with an active membership, including professional and associate members, as of the referral date.
- Referrals must be new, full-paying members who have not held NFUS membership in the last 12 months.
- Only full headline memberships qualify for referral rewards. Family or SAYFC

memberships are not eligible unless upgraded.

3. Referral process

To qualify as a valid referral:

- The new member must input the referring member's full name and membership number at the time of signing up.
- Referrals must be submitted by 15 October 2026.

NFUS is not responsible for referrals not correctly recorded due to missing or incorrect information.

4. Reward and discount

-

- A 10% discount will be applied to the referring member's 2027 full membership fee for each confirmed referral.
- Discounts are cumulative, up to a maximum of 10 referrals (100%).
- The discount applies only to the headline membership fee.
- Discounts will be applied after all referrals are verified and before the 2026 renewal invoices are issued.
- Any Group Secretary/staff member involved in the signing up process and completion of the application process will be rewarded as they would be normally.

5. Verification

- NFUS will verify all referrals between 16 - 31 October 2026.
- Discounts will only be granted if the referred members details are:
 - Included when a new member is signed up
 - The new member pays their membership for 2026/27.

6. Exclusions and limitations

- Self-referrals are not permitted.
- Duplicate referrals (where multiple members claim the same new member) will only be counted once, based on earliest valid submission.
- Referrals submitted after 15 October 2026 will not be counted.

7. Changes to the scheme

- NFUS reserves the right to modify, suspend, or terminate the scheme at any time, with or without notice.
- Any changes will be communicated via NFUS official channels.



8. Data protection

- NFUS will process member data in accordance with GDPR and our Privacy Policy.
- Referral information will only be used to administer this scheme.
